SUBJECT: Coronavirus Disease 2019 – Transition to Health Protection Condition
Alpha on the Pentagon Reservation

The Pentagon Reservation continues to monitor Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) COVID-19 Community Levels and Department of Defense (DoD) guidance to determine appropriate COVID-19 workplace safety protocols. Based on the Arlington County Community Level decreasing from “medium” to “low” on August 25, 2022, the Pentagon Reservation will transition from Health Protection Condition (HPCON) Bravo to HPCON Alpha effective 0500 on Wednesday, September 14, 2022.

For specific measures to be implemented under HPCON Alpha, follow the measures in reference (a) and, to the extent consistent, reference (b). Commanders and supervisors may implement additional, more stringent requirements, as appropriate, to mitigate risk.
